

# PICEA OMORICA SERBIAN SPRUCE

## Selected seed stand Valskov F.854

### Objective

Production of seeds of high quality for the production of timber and greenery.

### Origin

The plant material is offspring of a seed consignment H.156 (imported in 1958/1959) harvested in Hamburg, Ohlsdorf, district Friedhoff (Germany).

### Selection criteria

Valskov F.854 is representative for its species being homogeneous, healthy, with a high growth energy and a narrow growth form.

### Genetic gain

Offspring of F.854 is expected to have the same quality as the selected seed stand.

### Recommended planting areas

Based on F.854's narrow growth form, the offspring is expected to be well suited for production of containerised Christmas trees. The offspring manages relatively well on frosty locations.
